Fighting Rules – Proposals 2026

JJIF Fighting Working group



The different objectives

- Main targets:
 - Clarifying grey areas in the rules
 - Reduce areas of interpretation
 - *Changes are necessary for the sport to evolve*



Composition working group



- Referees from different countries and Unions

PROCEDURE:



- Collect various information
- Presentations at meetings (since August 2025; +/- 12 meetings)
- Draft proposals
- Meetings with all unions
- Present to the GA - Bangkok 2025
- Board approval
- Publication
- Implementation January 2026

GENERALITIES



DEFINITION « BE ACTIVE »:



- A definition of being active will be added to clearly explain what we expect from athletes
- To avoid a passivity penalty, an athlete must be active

What does that mean?

- « Performing significant attacks with the intention of scoring points; false attacks or attacks without the intention of scoring points in part 1, falling in part 2, or remaining motionless in part 3 are considered passive actions »

PERSONNAL REQUIRMENT:



- Mouthpieces will no longer be mandatory for U18 and younger players but are strongly recommended! It is the responsibility of coaches and parents for younger players
 - the JJIF or the continental unions cannot be held responsible for accidents that occur during various tournaments or championships
 - still needs to be approved by the JJIF doctors and the Board

PART 1:



ENGAGEMENTS:



- Time:
 - The time to move on to Part 2 will now be only 20 seconds of engagements
 - Exception:
 - after a passivity for Part 2, the time remains the same, currently 15 seconds
- Numbers of engagements:
 - We will keep the number of 2 engagements after each “HAJIME”, to maintain balance between the parts
 - Exceptions - only one engagement at least is mandatory:
 - after a passivity penalty FOR Part 2
 - after applying at least two engagements and the fight being stopped for another penalty: going out of the mat, kicking the legs etc.

NEW:



- U16 categories must touch the opponent, including the head, to score points
- U14 categories and below (younger) cannot target the head at all

SCORES:



- Areas:

- Part of the body that must be touched to score:
 - a) Torso - above the belt → under the shoulder's line
 - b) Back - except spinal column area
 - c) Head - only circular movements
- Part of the body that must be used to score:
 - All areas covered by protective gear
 - Exceptions: Haito; Shuto; Yoko-Geri; Uramawashi-Geri; Mae-Geri

CRITERIAS:



- To score in part 1, the followings **MUST** be completed:
 - TOUCH the opponent, not harder than semi-contact
 - Be applied with Hikite/Hikiashi
 - Be applied with good dynamic, balance and control
- If these three criteria are fulfilled, Tori scores an IPPON worth 2 points (or 3 points for Mawashi & Ura-Mawashi to the head)
- If Tori touches AND fulfills only one of the other criteria, at best he can score a Waza-ari
- If a strike is partially blocked and fulfills the other criteria, the score for Tori will also be only a waza-ari at best

PENALTIES:



- As we can only strike with the foam parts of the protective gear, everything else is considered a prohibited technique = Shido
 - slap
 - knee strike
 - elbow strike
- In case of CHUI:
 - cancel all actions after the Chui and reset the time to the moment of the Chui (the criteria need to be discussed)

PART 2:



THROUWS WITHOUT GRIP:

- All foot sweeps, such as De-Ashi-Barai will score in Part 2 because they represent a perfect throwing technique



SCORES:



- Areas:
 - Fighting area
 - Safety area - should stop with a MATTE

SCORES:



- Criteria:
 - Throw the opponent in one flow completely on the side, chest or back with control, balance = **IPPON 2 points** - EXCEPTION for throws/techniques above the shoulders line, such as KATA-GURUMA or SEOI-NAGE will score **IPPON 3 points** if:
 - Tori stays in standing position with both feet on the floor.
 - Tori keeps the grip.
 - Throw the opponent in 2 steps but in the same movement = **waza-ari**
 - If Tori loses the grip during the throw, the score is **waza-ari** at best, no ippon can be given
 - Bridge defense CAN'T score an ippon, at best waza-ari, if the opponent lies completely down on the back after the defense. If he/she turns on the knees = **NO SCORE**
 - The opponent lands on elbows, knees, seating position = **NO SCORE**

PENALTIES:



- **NEW:** To avoid some kind of passivity, when an athlete goes out or pushes the opponent out, SONOMAMA will be announced to freeze the fight, the MR brings both athletes in the same position back to the center of the fighting area, gives the right penalty and restarts with YOSHI.
- Throwing the opponent on his/her head will be sanctioned by CHUI and can be straight HANSOKUMAKE if it's clear that it's on purpose.
- If Uke puts himself (herself) in danger, to avoid a score in Part 2 - MUBOBI will be given.
- An athlete who only blocks attacks is considered passive in Part 2.
An athlete who keeps their arms stretched out, without attempting to do anything else is also considered passive in Part 2.
An athlete who has an advantage in Part 2 (for example, who destabilizes his opponent by moving his arms back and forth), but who does not use his advantage is also considered passive.

PART 3:



CLARIFICATION:



- Turtle position = on elbows and completely closed, like a turtle shell
- All 4 position = arms stretched out and, on the knees
- An Osae-komi continues in a “turtle” position but stops in “all 4” positions

CLARIFICATION:



- If an athlete attempts a tai-otoshi from a kneeling position (part 3), there must be a pause when the foot is placed on the ground, and the attack is made. We can consider that they have returned to Part 2
- If there is no pause, no score is possible because they are throwing in Part 3

NEW:

- When there is an Osae-komi and Uke reaches the third tatami or goes out of the safety area (2m) by hand or body, but Tori still touches the fighting area, THE OSAE-KOMI WILL CONTINUE



SIGNS:



MODIFICATIONS:



- Spilt up “Dangerous techniques” on 4 signs like it was in the past to be much clearer and more understandable from everyone (coach's, athletes, audience, viewers, ...)
 - Hard contact
 - Straight to the face
 - Throwing out
 - Uncontrolled techniques

NEWS:



- 3 new signs will be defined and implemented:
 1. Kick to the legs:
because it's a fault that we see in almost every match, so it's not under a general sign like "forbidden techniques"
 2. Prevent passivity:
to warn of passivity before it is given. The warned athlete has 5 seconds to be active in the current part
 3. Chui's:
A sign should be defined for CHUIs in order to differentiate between these penalties and SHIDO's.

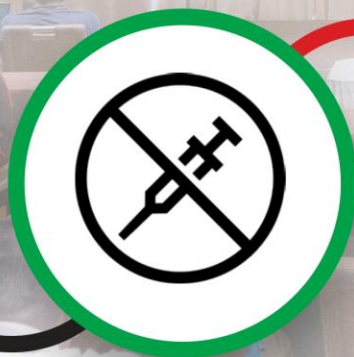

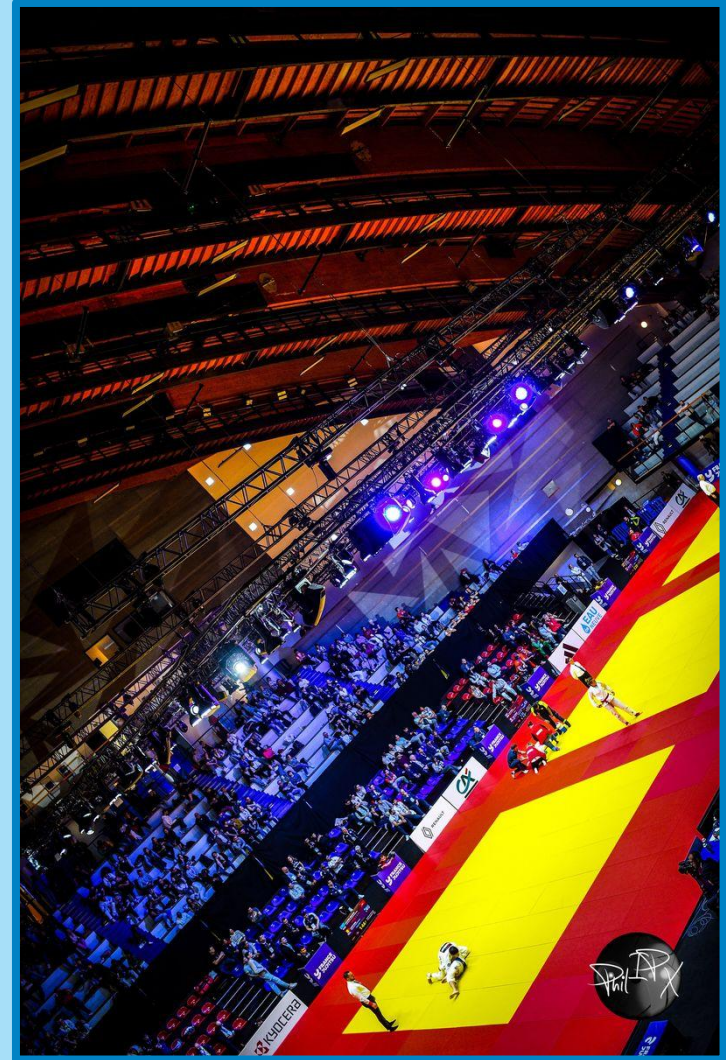

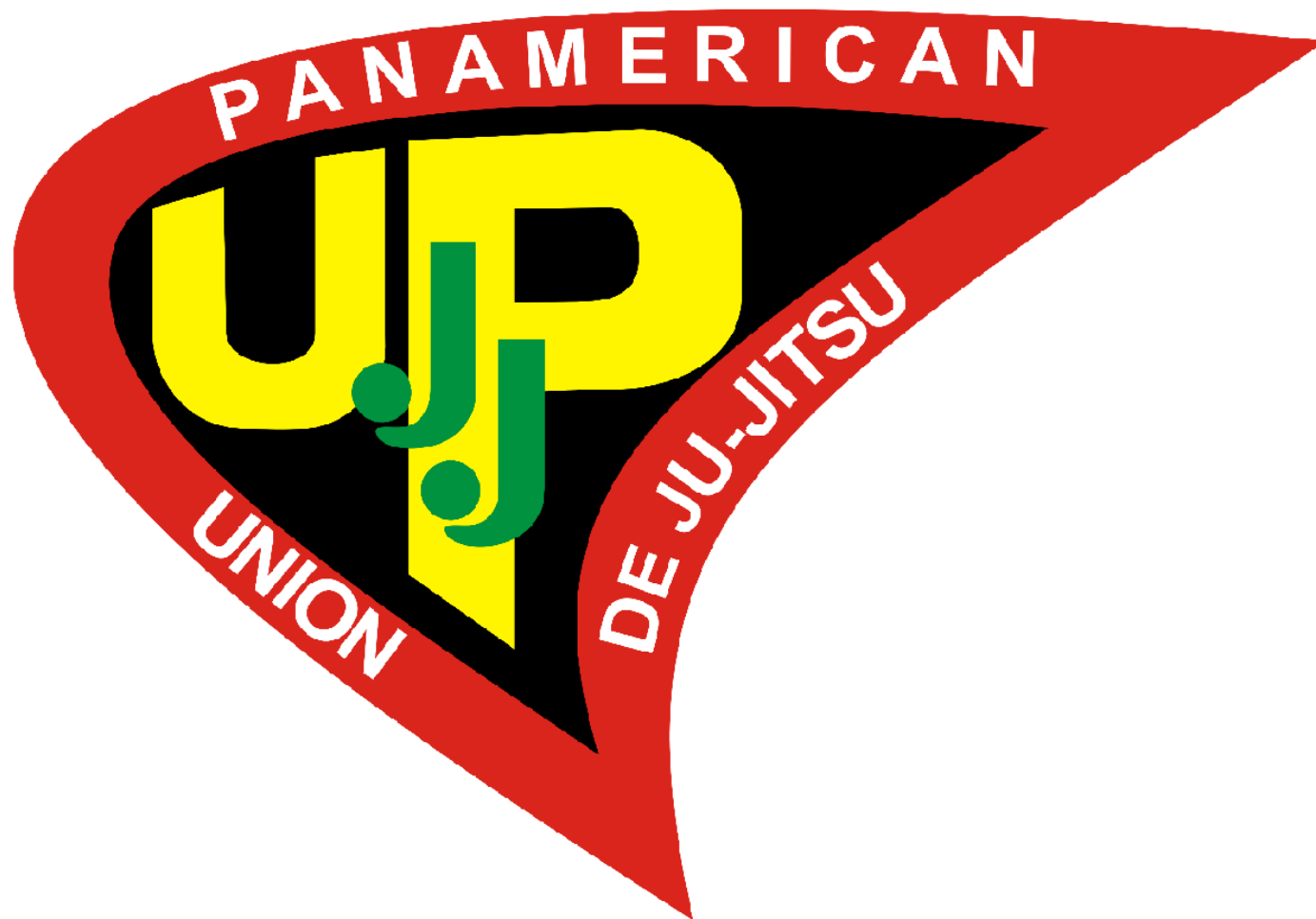
