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1 What to expect

The WSG are a major multi-sports event held every two years, full of sports, sports for all, cultural exchange, fun and new opportunities. These Games are not multisport games for top athletes but for all amateurs from different countries and cultures all over the world. Not only the organization of competitions is in the foreground, but also organizing a huge festival with the spirit of the beautiful region of Loutraki at the famous Corinthian Gulf. The objectives are the gathering of sports friends, as a worldwide family to advance making friends as well as the exchange of information, expertise and experiences within the multi-sport community of CSIT and its partners.

4 Participation

Participation is open to everybody practicing any style and discipline of Ju-Jitsu.

The event is designed to stay the full period of 5 days.

The CSIT is only offering full packages – there is no possibility to book only specific days.

6 The Competition: Right to participate and categories

Members of JJIF and/or CSIT can register their athletes directly in the event.

In the **U16** categories, **Medal winners** of the **World Championships 2024** are **not** allowed to participate.

In the **Masters** categories, athletes who participate under **Adults** in the **World Championships 2024** are **not** allowed to participate.

- All categories can be merged if there are not enough participants.
- JJIF will generate the draws and a live timetable on the SportData event page.
- There will be no seeding.

6.1 Disciplines

The event will feature the following disciplines:

- Fighting (only for the Master Divisions)
- Jiu-Jitsu (Gi and No-Gi)
- Duo System
- Show System

7 Participation: Grading and Styles

JJIF offers the recognition of styles!

The grades (Belts) of recognised styles can be approved and certified with a JJIF diploma.

During the CSIT games, we will provide a practical workshop on what to do and which eligible recognised styles and the respective grades are available on the spot.

8 Accreditation

The head of each delegation, or designated responsible person for each national federation, must verify the flag and the national anthem during the accreditation process.

10 Arrival, Departure and Transportation

The organization shall provide meeting points at Athens International Airport (ATH) where all participants should meet upon arrival. Information regarding transportation to the accommodation will be provided at the meeting points. LOC will not arrange transfers from any other airport. LOC and JJIF have agreed on the following arrival days:

- **June 3rd**: Arrival Day for participants

10.1 Transportation from and to the airport and train station Athens

Special branded (WSG-Logo) shuttle buses are available from and to the airport and railway station in Athens. To make sure LOC will provide enough shuttles from/to the airport we have attached a flight registration sheet. Please enter the last flight (to the **Athens International Airport (ATH)**) of your arrival and the first flight (from the **Athens International Airport (ATH)**) of your departure in the sheet.

- Please note that there is no guarantee for transport if you arrive outside the allocated times and places. JJIF/LOC does not organise any additional transport from the official one.
- Fees for Airport Athens shuttle are **50 EUR** per person

Game's participants get a **special offer** from "Aegean Airlines" - official partner of the 2025 CSIT World Sport Games – a **20% discount** on published Economy Class fares. In particular:

- This discount applies to all Aegean Airlines International or domestic flights
- Is valid only for Bookings during the period of the Games
- Booking has to be completed directly through Aegean Airlines-website

SINGLE BOOKINGS: Please note that there is **no limit** on the number of tickets you wish to book.

GROUP BOOKINGS: a) Federations and teams interested in making group bookings for airline tickets (up to 120 tickets) without initially providing the travelers' names should make their bookings through travel agencies that issue airtickets. In their communication with Aegean Airlines, the travel agency should specify that the request is for a group traveling to the 2025 World Sport Games, to receive the relevant discount. b) Federations and teams interested in making group bookings requiring more than 120 tickets without initially providing the travelers' names, may contact the CHARTER department of Aegean Airlines to arrange charter flight tickets. The package includes the following:

- Three meals per day at the catering centre or the hotel
- Transportation within the Games transportation network (venues, hotels)

Furthermore, there will be FICS services and information service desks. Please note that FICS chiropractic services will also be located at competition venues to treat accredited persons.

11.2 Participation fee [without accommodation]

This offer is for those who want to arrange their accommodation during the event by themselves.

This contribution will be **170 EUR** per person for Accreditation/ Participation only!

This includes the:

- Participation
- Accreditation ID-card, which allows access to venues, the athletes' village, opening and closing ceremonies, etc., according to the access levels established for the cardholder by CSIT and LOC
- Transportation within the Games transportation network (venues, athlete villages)

Delegates who are not accommodated within the Games transportation loop will be responsible for making their way to the athletes' village for meal service and participating in the Games transportation system.

Note that LOC and JJIF will not provide support or remedy issues for any accommodations secured through any non-partner providers.

11.3 Special offers for children

Into WSG2025 special package fees are tailor-made for children:

- All children (both athletes and accompanying adults) up to 12 years old have special prices for accommodation.
- Children who are accompanying people (not athletes) will be free of charge of the registration fees.

12 Visa

Determine if you need a Visa to enter Greece.

Depending on your country of origin, you may require a visa to enter Greece

(<https://www.mfa.gr/en/visas/visas-for-foreigners-traveling-to-greece/countries-requiring-or-not-requiring-visa.html>). You can request a visa from the Greek Embassy or Consulate in your country of residence and it will generally be issued after 90 days. The local organizer (CSIT) can support you with Visa letters.

13 Insurance

Each participant must possess individual health and accident insurance, including repatriation assistance.

JJIF is responsible for verifying the adequacy of this insurance.

14 Competition Dressing, Sponsors and Promotion

Please note that we will apply SC 4.1 Competition Dressing according to the size and quality of the Gi⁴.

14.1 Back Patches

Back Patches are not mandatory.

You can buy back patches for the event online. We are working on a special arrangement.

There will be NO Taylor at the event, so you need to add the back patches before the event.

15 Coaches, medical personnel and media from JJNOs

All coaches and medical personnel have to register to become “extra team officials” and access the venue and the field of play.

15.1 Coaches

All official coaches should receive their accreditation cards during accreditation.
All Coaches should attend the briefing meeting.

15.2 Medical personnel

JJNOs may have their medical personnel. To receive an accreditation card as medical personnel, attendance at the medical meeting⁵ is mandatory. They should be registered as officials for the event with the titles of Medics.

- Legal Practise for foreign medical and paramedical officers is limited and restricted according to the specific decisions of the state governor explicitly taken for the games. This means medical can only treat their own athletes.
- Request for treatments and analysis/test must come first from the participants through their official staff
- The LOC medical staff will work in close collaboration with them.

15.3 Dress code

According to GAISF guidelines, every competitor who has won a medal has to attend the ceremony to receive their trophy in person. Medal ceremony in Gi.

16 Anti-doping Control

All members should make their competitors aware that several athletes could be doping control. The WADA code for Doping Free sports will be applied. By entering the Championship, you accept the JJIF Anti-Doping regulations⁶.

If you are participating in the event and are taking any medication or plan to take any medication, please check with your doctor whether your medicine contains any substances on WADA's 2025 Prohibited List (<https://www.wada-ama.org/en/content/what-is-prohibited>)

You will need a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if it does. JJIF automatically recognizes all TUEs issued by National Anti-Doping Agency (NADAs), so please contact your NADA if you need a TUE and do not already have one. If you have any difficulty applying for a TUE through your NADO or no NADO in your country, please contact the JJIF.
